WHAT DOES THE FUND INVEST IN?

The primary objective of the Fund is the achievement of attractive dividend income coupled with long-term growth of capital, primarily through investment in a portfolio of equity or equity-related securities of issuers with business operations located throughout the world.

HOW RISKY IS IT?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a Fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility".

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

RISK RATING

Guardian Capital LP has rated the volatility of this Fund as low to medium.

This rating is based on how much the Fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.


Like most mutual funds, this Fund doesn't have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?

This section tells you how Series W Units of the Fund have performed over the past ten calendar years. Returns are after Fund expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the series returns.

Year-by-year returns

This chart shows how Series W Units of the Fund have performed in each of the past ten calendar years. The series dropped in value in three of the past ten calendar years. The range of returns and change from year to year can help you assess how risky the series has been in the past. It does not tell you how the series will perform in the future.



Best and worst 3-month returns

This table shows the best and worst returns for this series of the Fund in a 3-month period over the past ten calendar years. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

Average return

A person who invested \$1,000 in this series ten years ago now has \$2,273.95. This works out to an annual compound return of 8.56%.

WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?

This Fund may be suitable for you if:

- You are seeking long-term capital growth from your investment.
- You want to diversify your portfolio globally.
- You are comfortable with low to medium investment risk.
- You plan to hold this investment for the medium to long term.

A WORD ABOUT TAX

In general, you'll have to pay tax on any money you make on a fund including your share of the fund's earnings and on taxable capital gains from redeeming your investment. How much tax you pay depends on your tax rate, whether or not you hold the fund in a registered plan and the type of earnings of the fund (e.g. interest, dividends, capital gains, etc.). In general, you do not pay tax on your investments held in a Registered Retirement Savings Plan, Tax-Free Savings Account or other registered plan.

If you hold your investment outside of a registered plan, you will receive a tax slip showing your share of the fund's earnings. You must include the amounts shown in your taxable income whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested. You must calculate your taxable capital gains from redemption.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series W Units of this Fund.

The fees and expenses - including any commissions - can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales charges

You have to choose the initial sales charge option when you buy Series W Units. Ask about the pros and cons of this option.

2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the Fund's returns.

As at December 31, 2023, the Series W expenses of the Fund were 1.86% of its value. This equals \$18.60 for every \$1,000 invested.

More about the trailing commission

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you hold the Series W Units of the Fund. It is for the services and advice that your representative and their firm provide to you.

The trailing commission is paid to your representative's firm by the Manager, out of the management fee and is based on the value of your investment.

3. Other fees
